The Bird Paradise of Satakunta

The Puurijärvi-Isosuo National Park, located in the region of Satakunta, consists of vast marshland areas and the lush Puurijärvi Lake, which is an internationally significant bird destination.

The national park is well-suited for day trips, but also for overnight trip. You can spend the night at camping area along the Ala-Kauvatsanjoki River and there is a lean-to shelter also.

Puurijärvi Lake serves as an important resting place for waterfowl during the spring and autumn migrations, and it is completely protected from hunting. Movement on Puurijärvi Lake and Korkeasuo is prohibited during the thaw season. Additionally, movement on restricted areas of Isosuo, Kiettareensuo, Aronsuo, and Ronkansuo is prohibited between April 1st and July 15th.

Tips and rules

- You should preferably keep to the roads and marked trails.
- Camping is only allowed at campfire site of Ala-Kauvatsanjoki River.
- Always keep your pets on a leash.
- Do not feed or disturb grazing animals.
- Don't leave litter behind you, take it with you when you leave.
- Lighting fires is permitted only at the serviced campfire site of Ala Kauvatsanjoki River. Check the current warnings for forest or grass fire warning: en.ilmatieteenlaitos.fi/warnings.
