Kanavuori Trail

Nature is not far away, but in Central Finland! Hike and bike in our magnificent forests, experience the crystal-clear lakes, rivers and rapids, and fall in love with our five National Parks!



The Kanavuori trail is a diverse travel destination right next to the town of Vaajakoski, which can be accessed easily by taking a local bus or biking from Jyväskylä. The trail takes you to nearly 200 metres on Kanavuori hill, which offers magnificent views of Lake Päijänne and Lake Leppävesi.

Route description

The trail begins with a lush herb-rich forest and continues with a rocky and steep climb. Rope railings and stairs provide assistance for the most demanding sections. The top of the hill includes various easy rocky and forest terrains, but the paths are narrow in many areas. There are several places to enjoy the views along the trail. You can marvel at the magnificent boulder at the trail's turnaround location. The trail includes a variety of terrains, which can be demanding. As the route back goes along the same path, the trail ends in a steep descent on rocky terrain.




To the beginning of the route

The services of the Naissaari area are available to hikers in the immediate vicinity of Kanavuori. Signage to the trail and its map can be found in the parking lot of the Naissaari café (Naissaarentie 2, 40800 Vaajakoski) and at the start of the trail at the bottom of the hill.

Good to know

In addition to a diverse environment, Kanavuori has a spectacular view of the culturally and historically significant Naissaari region. It is recommended to travel on the trail when the ground is not frozen, as the path may be dangerously slippery in the winter due to ice and moisture. The nearest waste containers, water fountains and rest-rooms are located on the island of Naissaari. Please remember to take your trash with you when visiting the area. It is forbidden to light a fire in the area. The nearest campfire is located at the southern tip of the island of Naissaari.
