Bring your group to Pallas-Yllästunturi National Park, visit the wilderness areas of Enontekiö and introduce the visitors to Sámi culture. The exhibitions and short films at Fell Lapland Visitor Centre describe the eight seasons of the area and tell the story of how people of the north survived in the Arctic nature. The Visitor Centre's temporary exhibitions are also a nice addition to the services.

### The exhibition Vuovjuš – Wanderers introduces visitors to the nomadic culture of the Sámi.

In the old days the Sámi herded their reindeer, lived and moved around with them. The Sámi life and the change in lifestyle are told in the exhibition through stories, images, objects and historical films. Modern visitors can also learn from the relationship between nature and humans in the north.

Exhibition languages: fi,

se, ru, en, de, fr; audio guidance in Chinese.

### Children's exhibition Nestling

is an action-packed introduction to nature and life on the fells, where the little ones can learn about local baby birds. At Nestling's wilderness hut, young hikers can enjoy imaginative picnics by the old oven.

### Jyppyrä Trail

is the shortest route to the national park's most photogenic fell

landscapes. It is also the nearest spot where you can admire the magical midnight sun. On Jyppyrä Snowshoe Trail in the middle of the trees with a heavy snow load, you can experience the pastel colours of the polar night and starry winter skies. Jyppyrä Campfire Hut welcomes you to warm up around the fire.

### Café Peura serves visitors at the Visitor Centre (Kahvilapeura.fi).

All facilities of the Visitor Centre are accessible for wheelchair users with an assistant.
