Pallastunturi Visitor Centre is located right in the heart of Pallas-Yllästunturi National Park and has long traditions as the oldest visitor centre in Finland. It offers information about fell nature and hiking, local culture, services and attractions of the area.

The Visitor Centre's permanent exhibition, 'From Forests to Fell Tops'

explains how the fells were formed and introduces visitors to plants and animals of both the forests and the treeless fells. The exhibition presents animal and plant species in their natural habitat and explains how they survive in the severe conditions of the wild. Exhibition languages: fi, sv, en, de, fr, it; audio guidance in Chinese

The Reading Corner has books about nature, hiking and local history. Books, drawing materials

and games are provided for children, as well as tasks related to the exhibition and Vatikuru Nature Trail.

The Visitor Centre offers easy access to the most magnificent landscapes of the national park.

Put your snowshoes on and conquer Palkaskero Fell, or why not take in more than just one peak!

Vatikuru Nature Trail introduces visitors to the nature and culture of the area.

Taivaskeronkierros Trail brings hikers to the highest

peak of Pallas-Yllästunturi National Park

Pyhäjoki Nature Trail shows the lush nature of the herb-rich forests and its species around the Pyhäjoki River. The steep riverbank cliffs and old forests create a special ambiance on the trail.

Pallaskota Rental Hut is set in a beautiful grove of Mountain birches in a distance less than one kilometre from the Visitor Centre. In the hut, you can enjoy a peaceful cup of coffee at the foot of the fells.
