A visit to Kellokas will add value to your product and provides a deeper understanding of the protected nature.

The Our life ('Meän elämää') exhibition

gives plenty of information about the villages, the streams trickling down the fells as well as the forests, mires and meadows in the Pallas-Yllästunturi National Park. Life in the villages has revolved around the Tornion-Muonionjoki River, which is known as the river of life.

Exhibition languages: fi, sv, en, de, fr; audio guidance in Chinese.

The Life of the Brown Trout

exhibition tells the story of this endangered fish species of Finnish waters. Äkäsjoki, Kuerjoki, Naami-joki and Valkeajoki rivers are important living environments of the Brown trout.

Children's nature experience

starts with the Nature Spotting exhibition and culminates in the fascinating exhibits down-stairs, which children can explore by completing different tasks. Children

also have fun outdoors at the playground and on family-friendly short trails.

Varkaankurunpolku Trail

winds through a gorge in the lush and magical herb-rich forest. On this short and easy hiking trail, you will see proud old spruce trees and a tinkling fell stream.

The restaurant-cafeteria serves visitors within the Visitor Centre.

All facilities of the Visitor Centre are accessible for wheelchair users with an assistant.
